17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Any person who violates any provision of Subsection A of Section [3 or Sections 5, 7, 8 or 9 of the Tobacco Products Act] <u>30-49-3 NMSA 1978 or Section 30-49-7,</u> <u>30-49-8 or 30-49-9 NMSA 1978</u> is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978. Each violation is a separate and distinct offense.
